Profession Of Faith From The Church Of Constantinople in the year 325 CE

"I renounce all customs, rites, legalisms. unleavened breads and sacrifices of lambs of the Hebrews, and all other feasts of the Hebrews, sacrifices, prayers, aspersions, purifications, sanctifications and propitiations and fasts, and new moons, and Sabbaths, and superstitions, and hymns and chants and observances and Synagogues, and the food and drink of The Hebrews; in one word, I renounce everything Jewish, every law, rite and custom and if afterwards I shall wish to deny and return to Jewish superstition, or shall be found eating with The Jews, or feasting with them, or secretly conversing and condemning the Christian religion instead of openly confuting them and condemning their vain faith, then let the trembling of Gehazi cleave to me, as well as the legal punishments to which I acknowledge myself liable. And may I be anathema in the world to come, and may my soul be set down with Satan and the devils."1Source: Parks, James The Conflict Of The Church And The Synagogue Atheneum, New York, 1974, pp. 397 - 398. Knowing that Our Savior, Yahushua, was a Torah Observant Hebrew, how could anyone believe they were following Him after taking this oath?

New Religion

 This Constantine-approved profession effectively replaces the faith that Yahushua, the Apostles, Paul and thousands of Jews and Gentiles practiced. Tammuz Icons

 The use of crosses, as religious symbols, did not start with Christianity, but reaches far back into antiquity. Variations can be found in almost every ancient religion. Judaism and Islam are both exceptions; both comply with the second commandment laid down by Moses.

High Priest of Babylon

• Constantine took for himself the title of "Pontifex Maximus"(2), which also became one of the titles used by popes for many centuries. Like most of the customs and traditions of the new church, it was Babylonian in origin, a title of the high priest in Babylon(3).

Unconquerable Sun Day

 The year of 312 AD, sometimes given as the time of Constantine's conversion, is made specious by Contantine's enactment of a law, making Sunday the day of rest and worship throughout the empire. Constantine's own religion was Sol Invictus (The Unconquered Sun). The Christian and Hebrew Sabbath was on the 7th day of the week.

Doctrine of Balaam

• From 320-330 he began to attack paganism through the government but in many cases persuaded people to follow the laws by combining pagan worship with Christianity. He made December 25th,

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the birthday of the pagan Unconquered Sun god, the official holiday it is now--the birthday of Jesus. It is likely that he also instituted celebrating Easter and Lent based on pagan holidays.

As a true Apostle Paul had a prophetic eye.

1 Timothy 4 "¹Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;² Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron;³ Forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from meats, which God hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth."

A Master Deceiver fools the whole world

Revelation 12:9 And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him."

Revelation 20:3 "And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that <u>he</u> should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season."

When YHWH says "Come out of Babylon" it ought to be clear what He is referring to.
